**MakerSpace 4th-5th graders** : Makerspace is a hands-on, STEM program that encourages students to design and problem solve. Each day students will tackle solving a new challenge and learn to work creatively in teams to solve the task at hand.

**Science/Nature** : Students K-5 will become scientists and explore nature and animals! Led by a Kane County Naturalist, this group will be adventuring into the adjacent Forest Preserve. **You must have signed parent permission to be outside for this club.** This group will also have the opportunity to meet various native animals including a very special raptor presentation!

**Sports** : This program will give athletes K-5 a taste of several different sports. Learn self defense with Bill Cho, Soccer with Tri-Cities, and so much more!
