Special Night for Special Kids

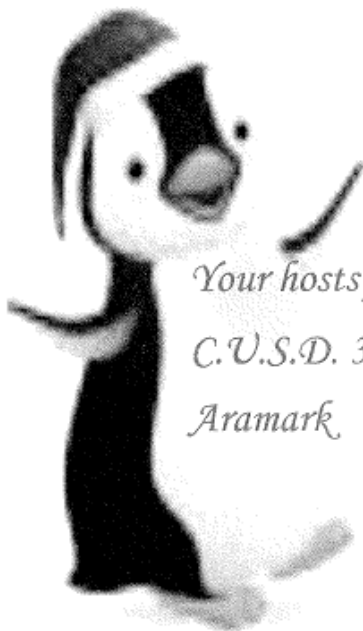
This FREE event for special needs children and their families features tons of fun activities and a special visit from Santa and his elves!

Kids can decorate cookies and gingerbread houses, play games and participate in arts and crafts and classic holiday stories will be read to them by our high school future educators.

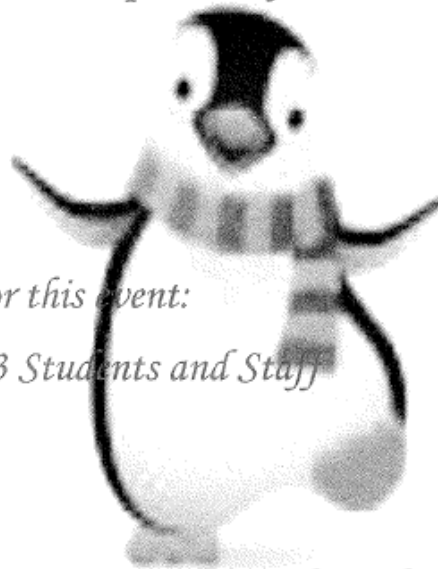
